The Swiss Football League (SFL) is one of the most important sports associations in Switzerland. It is responsible for organising and running the professional football championships in the two highest Swiss leagues, the Super League and the dieci Challenge League. Its headquarters are in Bern.

## Your tasks in our stadiums

- In the newly created role of Match Delegate for the 2025/26 season, you will take on the central coordination between the clubs, the TV rights holders, the TV production and the SFL in the Super League stadiums before, during and after the games
- Your goal is to ensure flawless match operations and high broadcast quality
- You will play an important role and act as an ambassador for the SFL
- You observe and verify compliance with the relevant regulations and directives
- You document safety- and security-related incidents
- You prepare and follow up on assignments and submit match reports
- You will receive thorough training from the SFL so that you can perform your role competently
- Please indicate in your application which Super League stadiums you would be available to work in next season

## Your prerequisites for our starting line-up

- Calm and level-headed personality: Friendly, confident manner, good observer, stays calm and collected even in hectic situations
- Quick comprehension: Can grasp situations quickly, understands contexts and can work his way into topics (e.g. TV production)
- Solution-oriented: Tackles problems proactively, makes suggestions, looks for solutions
- Good communication skills: Listens carefully, engages with stakeholders, communicates briefly and concisely. Can communicate well in at least two languages: German, French, Italian, English
- Ideally, some connection to (sports) events and/or TV production
- Strong service orientation, high reliability, neutrality and trustworthiness
- Willingness to work evenings and weekends combined with travel (6 to 8 h/matchday)
- At least 25 years old
